DECISION

UNIVERSITY OF SASKATCHEWAN RADIOACTIVE WASTE MANAGEMENT FACILITY OPERATING LICENCE

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission, pursuant to section 24 of the *Nuclear Safety and Control Act*, issues Waste Nuclear Substance Licence WNSL-W2-336-6.0/2002 to the University of Saskatchewan, Saskatoon, Saskatchewan. The licence is valid from August 1, 2000 to July 31, 2002 unless suspended, amended, revoked or replaced.

In reaching this decision the Commission considered the information and submissions of Commission staff and the participants as set out in the material available for reference on the record file as well as the submissions provided or made by the participants at the hearing. The Commission found the facts to be as set out in CMD 00-H14 and agreed with the submissions, statements of law, conclusions and recommendations set out in that document. As a result of that information, the Commission was of the opinion that the applicant satisfies the requirements of section 24 of the *Nuclear Safety and Control Act*.
